New features and enhancements

For this release we have introduced the following new feature:

- **AlphaVAT Reports – Exporting transaction data:** You can now export your transaction data relating to an entity's AlphaVAT calculation, into a Microsoft Excel file. This feature has been added in response to customer requests and aids review, particularly where there is a large volume of transactions.

Improved user interface

We have made the following improvements to the user interface and layout:

- **Tool tips:** Additional tool tips have been added to improve navigation.
- **Visual consistency:** We have made a range of improvements to visual consistency across the application.

Bug fixes

We have fixed the following bugs that have been previously identified:

AlphaVAT and AlphaBridge

- **Add new entity:** We have fixed a bug which erroneously displayed the VAT Group Name selection box, when creating a new single demo entity.
- **AlphaVAT: Bring forward file/data mapping and filters:** We have fixed an issue which prevented the file/data mapping and filters selected for an entity's previously prepared VAT Return, being brought forward when preparing the the VAT Return for their next obligation.
- **Block and exclude:** We have resolved an issue that affected the ability to search for a transaction.
- **Multi-click issue:** We have resolved a bug on the run calculation feature, where clicking it multiple times affected the calculation results.



Back end enhancements

System processes

- **CSV file delimiters:** We have enhanced this to support the following characters:
 - Caret ^
 - Pipe |
 - Semi colon ;
 - Tab
 - Tilda ~

System Infrastructure

This release includes a major infrastructure upgrade. These changes are required to prepare the way for future upgrades in February, where we plan to deliver:

- Our upgraded calculation engine
- New features such as the ability to perform VAT calculations, where customers have Partial Exemption Special Method agreements with HMRC.

Please note that these changes will have no visible customer impact, following this release.
